The Library offers the Information Research Skills workshops for students. We teach you how to search quickly and effectively through:

(i)Planning your search (ii) Searching the library catalogue (iii) Expert tips for searching popular databases (iv) In-text citations and reference lists using notable style guides (v)Use of EndNote, a citation management software

Postgraduate Students

Information Research Skills is embedded in the PG programme for **14.5** hours per semester targeting newly registered PG students; PG Diploma, Masters and PhD.

Students learn quick search strategies in:

(i)Subject special databases (ii)Advanced mode of search engines (iii) Expert tips for searching databases (iv) Using EndNote and notable style-guides (v)Datasets & visualizations (vi)Correct theses presentation
