All students and staff to the beginning of a new academic year in semester 1/2023 with a special welcome to students enrolling at USP for the first time!



4 USE ONLINE ACCESS CATALOGUE (OPAC) IN ENTERPRISE – TO FIND RESOURCES IN THE LIBRARY

The library offers a web based integrated library system called **Symphony**.

The public face of Symphony is called *Enterprise* which runs the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC).

To find resources in the library, search OPAC in Enterprise, by visiting the <u>USP library website</u> to search the <u>OPAC</u>.


5 GET TO KNOW YOUR LIBRARY STAFF

6 GET TO KNOW ABOUT INFORMATION RESEARCH SKILLS (IRS)

What is IRS?

To acquire the **KNOW HOW** set of skills and abilities to carry out library and information research tasks effectively and efficiently. These skills and abilities include *how to discover, access, interpret, analyze, manage, create, communicate, store, and share information.* IRS is the "application of the competencies, attributes and confidence needed to make the best use of information and to interpret it judiciously. It incorporates *critical thinking and awareness*, and an *understanding of both the ethical and political issues* associated with using information." (CLIP 2018).

USP professionals across the USP Library Network *teach Information Research Skills* that you need to *enable you to successfully complete assignments and research* at undergraduate and post-graduate levels.

There are a variety of IRS courses/sessions available to you, to mention a few, librarians help you

- to locate information using the library website;
- to use and search the Online Public Access Catalogue in Enterprise;
- find the most relevant articles and materials for your assignment;

- use electronic resources;
- to reference a citation using MLA, APA etc.;
- use referencing tools like EndNote and Mendeley;
- Know about the research process from Planning your research to Measuring Impact
