The services we provide are:

- Senior Peer Mentoring (SPM) sessions: support facilitated by a high-achieving student who has excelled in the course, which can help you increase your academic performance (200- and 300-level courses)
- PASS (Peer Assisted Study Sessions): support facilitated by a high-achieving student who has excelled in the course, which can help you increase your academic performance (100-level courses)
- Academic Skills Workshops: a series of tailor-made workshops designed in collaboration with and on the advice of course coordinators, where you get an opportunity to try out using academic and English learning skills
- Face-to-Face consultations (Drop-in): where you get to discuss specific academic and learning issues face-to-face with a Learning Specialist
- E-mentoring consultations: assisting students via email
- Study guides: Printed and soft copies of study guides on specifically targeted areas of skill achievement.
