



Pacific European Union Marine Partnership (PEUMP) Scholarships

CALLS FOR APPLICATIONS: CERTIFICATE IV IN TRAINING & ASSESSMENT

Applications are invited from suitable Fijian-based marine and fisheries management personnel for the **Certificate IV in Training & Assessment (CTA) programme**.

The CTA programme will be offered by cohort basis (8 weeks) from **6th July - 28th of August, 2020**.

Scholarships are funded through the USP component of the Pacific-European Union Marine Partnership Programme.

DESCRIPTION:

This programme reflects the roles of individuals delivering training and assessment services in skills based qualifications and programmes. The skills set derived from the units of competencies within the programme is also suitable for those engaged in the delivery of training and assessment of competence in a workplace context, as a component of a structured skills based programme. This qualification provides a pathway for employment as a trainer in the TVET or in the workplace.

ELIGIBILITY/ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have:

- (i) Pass in Senate recognized Form 6/Year 12 or equivalent with English and minimum of two years work experience; or
- (ii) Extensive workplace, TVET or adult training experience with recommendation from the employer;
- (iii) Cleared any pending student holds at USP;
- (iv) No other registrations in any existing programmes offered at USP.

COURSE INFORMATION

The 4 courses of the programme are: CET41 – Design & Develop a Learning Programme; CET42 – Processes & Methodologies of Training; CET43 – Plan and Deliver Training; CET44 – Assessment, Evaluation and Validation & Training.

ONLINE SESSIONS: 7 weeks (13th July to the 28th of August, 2020)

FACE TO FACE SESSION: 1 week (6th to the 10th of July, 2020)

The project will cover tuition fees and face-to-face session costs of the programme.
