The library eResources webpage lists the types of electronic and online resources which are readily available to you to browse, search and use.


There are six access headings namely:

- <u>A-Z databases</u>
- Find Journals and eBooks
- Exam Papers
- Open Access and Open Educational Resources
- USP Theses Portal
- <u>PIMRIS</u> which holds the Moana database, PIMRIS regional repository and USP Aquatic repository

There are different types of databases:

- Full-text contains the full-text of journal articles etc.,
- often able to download as PDF.
- Indexing and abstracting offer details about the item but not the full-text.
- Audio-visual allow you to download or stream images, video, or sound.



The library is reaching out to non-*ORCID* holders – contact your <u>Liaison Librarian</u> and register today!




5 GET TO KNOW YOUR LIBRARY STAFF
