## 3 Discover & Navigate Your Databases & eResources

The library eResources webpage lists the types of electronic and online resources which are readily available to you to browse, search and use.

There are six access headings namely:

- [A-Z databases](#)
- [Find Journals and eBooks](#)
- [Exam Papers](#)
- [Open Access and Open Educational Resources](#)
- [USP Theses Portal](#)
- [PIMRIS](#) which holds the Moana database, PIMRIS regional repository and USP Aquatic repository

There are different types of databases:

- Full-text – contains the full-text of journal articles etc., often able to download as PDF.
- Indexing and abstracting – offer details about the item but not the full-text.
- Audio-visual – allow you to download or stream images, video, or sound.

In partnership, the Library and the Research Office are advocating for ORCID (Open Researcher and Contributor ID) to promote and strengthen research recognition and developments at the USP.

**ORCID**  
Connecting Research and Researchers

The USP Library encourages all USP staff (learning and teaching/research) and postgraduate students to have a registered ORCID ID.

**What does an ORCID identifier look like?**  
ORCID identifiers are a 16 digit number in four blocks of four digits, expressed as a URL that links to your profile e.g. <https://orcid.org/0000-0002-4650-2247>

**To register for an ORCID ID:**  
<https://orcid.org/register>  
Use your USP email when you sign up

**How can I find out if I already have an ORCID?**  
Search for your name in the ORCID Registry

**What happens if I leave USP?**  
You own your ORCID profile. It will travel with you to your next institution. Make sure you update your email address in your profile settings

**ADD YOUR WORKS**  
There are 4 ways to add works to your ORCID record:

1. Search & Link to connect your ORCID ID to information in other records e.g. SCOPUS-Elsevier, Researcher ID (Web of Science)
2. Import a BibTex file of your research works for later use on Management Tools e.g. EndNote.
3. Manually type in information about your work
4. Importing publications from Google Scholar
