## 4 DISCOVER & NAVIGATE YOUR DATABASES & ERESOURCES

The library eResources webpage lists the types of electronic and online resources which are readily available to you to browse, search and use.


There are six access headings namely:

- [A-Z databases](#)
- [Find Journals and eBooks](#)
- [Exam Papers](#)
- [Open Access and Open Educational Resources](#)
- [USP Theses Portal](#)
- [PIMRIS](#) which holds the Moana database, PIMRIS regional repository and USP Aquatic repository

There are different types of databases:

- Full-text – contains the full-text of journal articles etc., often able to be downloaded as PDF.
- Indexing and abstracting – offer details about the item but not the full-text.
- Audio-visuals – allow you to download or stream images, video, or sound.

**ProQuest Ebook Central**

Ebook Central offers authoritative ebooks in a wide range of subject areas, along with powerful tools to help you find, use, and manage the information you need. It provides credible content from authoritative, scholarly sources, including University Presses and other top publishers.

To access **Ebook Central** click on the link provided or you can find it in the Library's **Database list** under **E-Resources** on the **Library Website**.

Ebook Central is designed with mobile in mind. Access the site from your tablet or phone, and download ebooks for offline reading or select the "Read Online" option.



**Cambridge Core**

Cambridge Core provides access to 1.6 million journal articles and select e-books, including textbooks such as *An Introduction to International Criminal Law Procedure and International Environmental Law*.

This database is especially good for finding sources in the arts, humanities, and social sciences. You may also use Cambridge Core to make suggestions for ebooks for the library to purchase.

To access **Cambridge Core** click on the link provided or you can find it in the Library's **Database list** under **E-Resources** on the **Library Website**.

There is a Liaison Librarian for every school and discipline. These Librarians provide specialised support for both students and academic staff in their subject areas.


**Liaison Librarians:**
