Regional students at other campuses should contact their Campus Admin Office or their Student Administrative Services office(r) for their examination venue.

**Exam timetable** is now available on your Student SOLS account under the “My Timetable” link and it shows the date, time and venue of your exam.

*Note that the exam venue shown on your personal timetable is only for **Laucala Campus** students.*

- Be on time. You should be at the exam venue at least 1/2 an hour before each exam starts
- Make sure you appear at the correct time and date for your examination
- Make sure you have a USP photo **ID**  
Other materials allowed into the exam venue:
- **DO NOT** bring any valuables or bags to the examination venue because USP is not responsible for this
- Do not bring any mobile phone, laptop, tablet or any other electronic device into the examination venue
- If you are doing an online **Final Test**, ensure that the keyboard and desktop are working well.

There are different types of databases:

- Full-text – contains the full-text of journal articles, etc., often able to be downloaded as PDF.
- Indexing and abstracting – offer details about the item but not the full-text.
- Audio-visual – allow you to download or stream images, video, or sound.




