Applications:

Applicants must be citizens of a USP member country, and must be 35 years or younger for Masters studies and 45 years or younger for PhD studies at the time of application to be considered for the scholarship. The application must be accompanied by the Applicant Detail Form, an outline of a proposed research topic which demonstrates knowledge of the proposed subject. Applicants may discuss their applications with a potential supervisor. Applicants should also submit a full CV, certified true copies of their academic transcripts, and the names and contact details of three referees.

Please note:

- Final year undergraduate students who wish to apply for the **Pacific Scholarship for Excellence in Research & Innovation** need to explicitly state the expected date of completion of their current programme in the application letter.
- Applicants must enrol in their respective academic units; the award for this scholarship does not guarantee a place in the academic unit.
