

STUDENT BURSARY SCHEME: SEMESTER 2 2023

The USP Student Bursary Scheme provides financial assistance to private Undergraduate and Postgraduate level students of USP member countries.

The scheme will cover:

1. up to 50% of the total tuition fees for non-repeated courses in Semester 2 2023 only.
2. one student per family (*i.e.*, a student in a nuclear family whose tuition fees is higher than another eligible member of that same nuclear family; both of whom are supported by the same parents/guardians)

Eligibility criteria:

Applicants must:

1. Be a citizen of one of the USP Member countries.
2. Have completed at least one academic term at USP.
Note: New students, who haven't studied at USP before, are not eligible for this bursary until they have completed a semester/trimester at USP.
3. Have a term GPA of 2.5 or above in the most recent academic term
4. Have a combined family income of not more than FJD 25,000 per year.
Note: A Statutory Declaration form must be completed and signed by a Justice of Peace (or person(s) authorized by the Ministry of Justice) if the self-funding applicant or parents/guardians supporting the applicant is not formally employed.
5. Not be admitted to Unclassified Programmes.
6. Not be supported by other scholarship schemes, including TSLs Schemes for Fijian undergraduate students.
Note: Fijian Students applying for this

bursary for the first time must provide confirmation from TSLs that you are not eligible for any TSLs schemes.

7. Not be eligible for the USP Staff Sponsorship & Fee Concession.
8. Not be enrolled in a Doctoral or DRP programme
9. Not be enrolled in self-funding programmes offered by GSB, PTAFE and PDLP/PDLD.
10. [For Continuing Research Students] Submit a recent progress report endorsed by the Faculty Research Committee.
11. Applications must be legible and should have the required documents as listed in the application form Checklist.
Note: Incomplete and illegible applications will not be considered.
