Abstract from Thesis

"A Reference Architecture for Context-Aware Mobile Learning Applications"

Context-aware mobile learning applications are developed to provide learning materials to suit the needs of individual learners. Most of these applications are built in isolation, with each application having its own architecture and structure. With the lack of guidance for developing context-aware mobile learning applications, there are many challenges, such as; i) lack of homogeneity (standardization) in the development of such applications, ii) increased development cost since each developer has to define their own process and methods, iii) poor quality of developed application in terms of correctness and coverage of requirements. In order to address these challenges, a reference architecture (Ref-CAMLA) was designed to guide the development of context-aware mobile learning applications. Design science research methodology was adopted that included five key activities; explicate the problem, define requirements, design, demonstrate, and evaluate the artifact. Requirements were gathered from twenty-six different context-aware mobile learning applications, and Ref-CAMLA was designed and described using the conceptual, module, runtime, and deployment view. As a proof of concept, Ref-CAMLA was instantiated, and context-aware mobile learning applications were developed. Finally, Ref-CAMLA was evaluated using a checklist-based inspection and reference architecture model. The results indicate that Ref-CAMLA solves the motivated problem and has the necessary elements required of a reference architecture. The thesis concludes by providing the main contributions to theory and practice, limitations, and outlining directions for future research work.

Abstract from Thesis

"Teachers' and Principals' perceptions and practices of character education in selected Fijian Secondary Schools"

The purpose of this study was to explore the teachers' and principals' perceptions and practices of character education in selected Fijian secondary schools. The study employed a mixed-methodology consisting of quantitative and qualitative approaches. A total of twenty-four secondary schools involved in this study from which 282 participants who are teachers responded to the survey questionnaire and 15 principals were selected for the interviews. The analysis of the quantitative and qualitative data obtained from teachers and principals reveal that character education is perceived as quintessential for children's character development and generally character education is well supported by civil society. Also, the findings indicate that God is seen as the source of character education in the schools and currently character education is not prioritised in schools.

Furthermore, according to the teachers the current teachers are adequately trained to teach character education, an observation which the principals differed on. The principals stressed that the current teachers are academic specialists who are drafted in only to play a stand-in role for the unavailable character education specialists. The teachers and principals also differed in the area of curriculum. The principals diverged from the teachers who assumed that the schools do have character education curriculum. The principals asserted that there is no formal character education curriculum. Likewise, the principals differed from the teachers on the issue of adequate resource allocation. The principals highlighted that critical character education resources are needed in schools. Furthermore, the teachers viewed that the implementation of character education is effective, a claim which the principals' response refuted.

Religious activities play a leading role in the quest to promote character education. Further, the study facilitated the development of a Divine Character Education Model to teach character education.

Abstract from Thesis

"Changes in the structure, diversity and functional richness of Viti Levu's montane rainforests under the impact of invasive alien ivory cane palm (Pinanga Coronata)"

The invasive alien ivory cane palm (Pinanga coronata) is suspected to be affecting the structure and diversity of rainforests in the Colo-i-Suva Forest Park, Fiji, by dislacing native plant species, altering abiotic and biotic variables and influencing the functional traits of native understorey plants. Thirty-five permanent plots were established along the invasion gradient in two of the park's reserves, Colo-i-Suva (CIS), a mahogany plantation with a native understorey, and the semi-natural lowland rainforests of Savura. Within each 20 x 10 m plot, eight 3 x 5 m subplots were regularly placed. Data collected included plant species counts in each subplot within the three structural layers of the rainforest. In each subplot, air temperature and moisture were recorded using data loggers. A portable soil pH meter was used for soil pH measurements for each subplot. PAR data was measured by using a plant canopy imager. Data taken for the analyses of functional traits included plant height, plant volume, Leaf Dry Matter Content, Specific Leaf Area, Leaf Nitrogen content and Leaf CN ratio (C:N). Data from 31 species were analysed to assess trait-convergence and trait-divergence patterns.

The density and abundance of P. coronata was higher in CIS and particularly high in the herb and shrub layers. P. coronata dominance varied throughout both reserves ranging from subplots with a very high dominance to subplots with low dominance in all structural layers with the herb layer being most affected in both reserves. Increasing density of P. coronata populations was negatively correlated to the diversity and richness of native plants. The presence of dense P. coronata stands was also correlated to significant changes on the abiotic and biotic properties, particularly a decrease in temperature and an increase in soil pH in heavily invaded areas. P. coronata had a significant impact on the functional traits of the native plants which converged to the traits of the invasive palm i.e. high specific leaf area (SLA), high leaf dry mass content (LDMC) and increased plant size in order to compete for resources. The presence of dense stands of mature P. coronata resulted in a significant impact on nitrogen, carbon nitrogen ratio, and biotic properties within the study sites. The results suggest that P. coronata is capable of fundamentally changing the diversity, structure, and functions of the affected rainforests, regardless of whether those forests are plantations or semi-natural. Management action to control P. coronata is urgently needed.

Abstract from Thesis

"Assessing Nutritional Values of Solomon Islands Edible Tropical Fruits"

The present study evaluated the concentrations of the macroelements (Mg, K, Ca and Na), microelements (Fe, Cu, Zn, Mn, Ni and Co), and six water soluble vitamins (WSVs: B1, B2, B3, B6, B9 and C) in selected tropical fruit samples from the Honiara Central market in Solomon Islands. Atomic absorption spectrometry was used for the determination of the macroelements and microelements while the WSVs were analyzed using high-performance liquid chromatography (HPLC) method. A rapid HPLC method was also developed for the simultaneous separation and routine analysis of six WSVs in fruit matrix. The principal component analysis showed two components each for macroelements and WSVs while microelements showed three components. The hierarchical cluster analysis also combined fruits of similar or proximate concentrations of WSVs, micro and macroelements in a single clade. Among microelements, Fe showed dominance in most fruits while Co was the least contained element in most fruits. The potassium showed dominance in all the fruits while Na was in least concentration. The WSVs profile showed the highest concentrations of thiamin, niacin and folic acid in cutnut. The estimated (%) covering of recommended dietary allowance (RDA) or adequate intake (AI) for microelements, macroelements and WSVs in the studied fruits demonstrated the highest covering of RDA/AI for children, followed by adolescents and adults. The study demonstrated a variation of nutritional values in different fruits for human health without any toxicity threat to the human. The understanding of the relative contribution of macroelements, microelements and WSVs toward the RDA/AI values will support dietary planning against vitamin and mineral deficiencies.

Abstract from Thesis

"Melanesians on the Margins: A Comparative Study of Melanesian Communities in Fiji and Sāmoa."

The research documents and examines an aspect of the history of the labour trade and the growth of plantations in Fiji and Sāmoa from the mid-nineteenth to the early twentieth century. Today's Melanesian descendants in Fiji and Sāmoa share the same emotional reaction to the labour trade, with many describing it as primarily about servitude and, to a lesser degree, kidnapping. This has influenced their views of how they live today, as marginalised, and oppressed members of society. The thesis compares the historical evolution of their identities and the social and economic status of these Melanesian minorities in their newly formed communities. To better understand the legacy of the Melanesian labour trade, case studies from five Melanesian communities in Fiji and Sāmoa were selected. The phenomenological qualitative method was used to interview Melanesian descendants in these communities, allowing them to share their lived experiences. Their stories formed the foundation of this study by shedding light on their backgrounds, life experiences, and current issues concerning their descendants. Melanesian descendants in Fiji and Sāmoa face similar challenges and insecurities regarding political representation, as well as access to housing, land, services, jobs, education, and training opportunities. Christian churches have played an important role in both communities' history and continue to play an important role in the development of their cultural identity. Notable differences were also observed in the way each community was integrated into indigenous Fijian and Sāmoan societies. Generations of Melanesian descendants conclude that without affirmative action policies from their governments, their hopes for change and a better future will be futile.

Abstract from Thesis

"A New Security Dimension: Implementation of the Women, Peace and Security Agenda in the Pacific Region"

In the field of Women, Peace and Security (WPS), limited research has focussed on nations in the south or investigated the perspectives of security practitioners. This research sought to fill this gap by engaging directly with military women from across four Pacific nations, to identify their perception of regional WPS implementation. This research was presented as a discrete research project, funded by the New Zealand Defence Force Strategic Engagements Branch. The aim was to establish a baseline appreciation of the challenges military women face within the Pacific and across wider WPS implementation. Data was collected through 42 interviews with serving military personnel, using semi-structured interview questions. These were grouped into themes and presented within one of the four WPS pillars (Prevention, Participation, Protection and Relief and Recovery). This thematic structure provides anonymity for the contributors. A Systems Theory approach to the data analysis allowed an understanding of the functions of complex organisations (such as the military). This signposted the variety of influences upon the organisation that challenge regional WPS implementation. The results indicate that most members had observed challenges and progress within WPS (through recruitment changes, infrastructure development and women's networks). The most prevalent issue discussed was the concept of a 'Pacific Mentality'. This was considered a barrier for women across their recruitment, retention, engagement and promotion and consequently limited the transformative potential of regional WPS. The relative and perceived lower status of women in the military appears to influence their ability to meaningfully contribute. Further policy development could encourage their contribution and enhance WPS implementation in the region. Engaging further with military men in future could also illustrate the current challenges associated with implementation of the WPS agenda.

The first three panels represent, in order from top, FIJI ISLANDS, TONGA, and SAMOA. In each case the central motif was adopted from a traditional tapa of each country. While the motifs appear to be stylised flower or star patterns, the symbolic significance of these ancient designs has long since been lost. This is also true of the more geometric elements of the border patterns. Other inspirations are more obvious: the Fijian comb pattern features at the top and the bottom of the entire tapa; frigate birds are between the panels for Fiji and Tonga; and cannibal forks feature between the Tonga and Samoa panels.

The fourth panel represents **SOLOMON ISLANDS** and has as its main motif a lengga nut design from a kap-kap shell ornament, which is traditionally worn around the neck. The striated triangles at the edges were taken from a carved war club.

The central motif for the fifth panel, representing **KIRIBATI**, is taken from a fine woven mat. This is bordered on each side by a stylised shark's tooth spear and is separated from the panel above by a design taken from the finely woven sinnet cord featured on the haft of the spear.

Between the fifth panel and the sixth panels representing **TUVALU**, is a turtle border design taken from a Fijian tapa. The Tuvalu star pattern is also taken from a mat design and the border represents the ancient bamboo flute which is still sometimes played in Tonga.

The seventh panel represents **COOK ISLANDS**. In the centre is a motif from a carved ritual adze from Mangaia while the bottom border is taken from a wooden food bowl.

The **VANUATU** panel beneath features a design from a rare ritual head-dress of the Banks Islands and is bordered by a pattern which is said to represent the marks made by crabs walking across wet sand.

The ninth panel is for **NIUE**. Its central motif, the bent cross pattern on the sides, and the flying birds which separate this panel from the one above are all taken from a very old tapa returned to Niue from New Zealand. The centre design is common throughout the entire Oceania/Indonesia region.

The panel for **TOKELAU** is taken from a woven mat, and is separated from that for Niue by a stylised crab design.

The eleventh panel represents **NAURU** and shows string figures, which are a traditional art form. The central figure tells a legend of twin babies fighting for milk at their mother's breast, while the side figures depict flying fish.

The final panel is for **MARSHALL ISLANDS.** The top and side borders come from a traditional Marshall Islands mat weave, refering to lineage and land inheritance. The side borders are joor, meaning pillar, and refer to the important positions of chiefs and lineage heads. The central motif is a navigation stick chart, rebbelib or meddo, used by the ancient sailing masters to chart currents and islands.

CEREMONIAL DRESS

The ceremonial dress of the University of the South Pacific was designed in light weight materials to be appropriate for tropical conditions. The principal colours reflect the brown of tapa or masi found throughout the Pacific, while the blue derives from the colour of the sea and the sky.

OFFICER'S ROBE

Chancellor: The gown is made from brown Indian silk with long sleeves lined with cream silk. The facings are six-inch (fifteen-centimetre) wide strips of specially designed tapa motifs representative of all the member countries of the University Region. The material is gathered at the yoke. The headgear is a trencher covered with brown Indian silk, with matching braid round the lower edge, and a brown tassel.

Pro-Chancellor: The gown is as for the Chancellor, but with the unlined sleeves. The headgear is as for the Chancellor without the braid.

Vice-Chancellor: The gown is as for the Pro-Chancellor, but the facings are four-inch (ten centimetres) wide strips of tapa. The headgear is as for the Pro-Chancellor.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Doctor of the University: The gown is in dark blue Indian silk with pleats on each side at the back. The sleeves have a horizontal lower edge and a slit in the front. Facings down the front of the gown are in light blue Indian silk, as are the linings of the sleeves. The hood is a simple cowl twice the size of the bachelor's hood with a lining in light blue. The headgear is a trencher in dark blue Indian silk with a light blue tassel.

Master of the University: A dark brown master's gown, with a light blue lining for the hood and front V attaching it. The headgear is a dark brown trencher.

Doctor of Philosophy: The gown is as for the Doctor of the University but the sleeves are unlined and the facings are in red. The hood is as for the Doctor of the University hood but the lining is red. The headgear is a trencher in dark blue Indian silk with a red tassel.

Master's Degree: Gowns should be of cotton in the dark brown colour of the usual deep shade of tapa cloth patterns, in a simple design with three pleats on each side at the back. The sleeves come down to knee level. The hood is a simple cowl lined with the following degree colours: forest green for Agriculture, gold for Arts, purple for Business Administration, teal for Commerce, cream for Education, aqua blue for Engineering, silver grey for Law, brick red for Medicine, palm green for Science; and pale pink for Master in Computing and Information Systems (MCIS) and Master of Information Systems (MIS). The front finished in a two-inch (five-centimetre) wide V which is in the degree colour. The headgear, which is optional, is a trencher in a light-weight matching brown fabric.

Master of Philosophy: A dark brown gown and plain dark brown hood.

Postgraduate Diplomas and Certificates: A dark brown gown only, the same colour and design as the master's degree.

Professional Diplomas and Certificates: A dark brown gown only, the same colour and design as the master's degree.

Bachelor's Degree: Gowns are of the same design as for the master's degree, but in a lighter shade of tapa brown. The hood is lined in the discipline colours as defined by the master's dress. In addition, orange is assigned for the Bachelor of Software Engineering (BSE) & Bachelor of Network and Security, and magenta for the Bachelor of Geospatial Science. The front V attaching the hood is in plain brown. The headgear, a trencher, is in the same light tapa brown of the gown.

Combined programmes: Where two programmes are completed simultaneously resulting in the award of 2 certificates, the recipient shall wear two hoods (each depicting the colour of the two qualifications) as part of their academic dress.

Diplomas and Certificates: A light tapa brown gown only, the same colour and design as the bachelor's degree.
