

How to Enrol in Physical Education course at USP



Bachelor of Education Major in Physical Education



The Physical Education Courses are designed to cater for students with an interest in Early Childhood Education & Care, Primary Education, Secondary Education, and Special & Inclusive Education.

Students enrolled in the following undergraduate programs can Major in Physical Education from Semester 1, 2021:

- **Bachelor of Arts Graduate Certificate in Education (BAGCED)**
- **Bachelor of Science Graduate Certificate in Education (BSCGCED)**
- **Bachelor of Commerce Graduate Certificate in Education (BCOMGCED)**

The undergraduate programs include all Pre-service Secondary Programmes and the Bachelor of Education (BED) Secondary In-Service.

Physical Education can also be taken as a second major in combination with other majors from the combined degree programmes.

Students enrolled in other USP Programmes may also enrol in the 100-level courses ED180 Human Movement and Culture in the Pacific, ED183 Swimming and Aquatic Safety, and ED184 Outdoor Education and Leisure.
