Working Paper Style Guidelines

Heading Level 1: Time New Roman size 14, Bold, All capitals

Heading Level 2: Times New Roman size 12, Bold

Heading Level 3: italics, Times New Roman size 12

1st paragraph after heading: Justified, spacing 1.5 lines, margins normal, Times New Roman size 12.

All other paragraphs: as above *plus* first line indent

Direct Quotes: justified and centred, spacing 1 line, Times New Roman size 12

APA Referencing Style

In text reference (surname date: pages -- Smith 1990: 2; Jones 1992: 44-5)

Reference list: justified, spacing 1 line, Times New Roman size 12

Surname, Initial. (date) 'Article Title', *Journal title*, Volume (Issue): pages

Kadir, S. (1999). 'The Islamic factor in Indonesia's political transition.' *Asian Journal of Political Science*, 7(2): 21-44.

Schedler, A. (1998). 'What is democratic consolidation?' *Journal of Democracy* 9(2): 91-107.

Book

Surname, Initial. (date) *Book Title*, Place: Publisher, pp.

Geertz, C. (1960). *The Religion of Java*. Chicago: Chicago University Press.

Book Chapter

Surname, Initial. (date) 'Chapter Title', in Initial Surname (eds), *Book title*, Place: Publisher, pp.

Young, K. (1999). 'The national picture - a victory for reform?' in S. Blackburn (ed), *Pemilu: The 1999 Indonesian election*. Melbourne: Monash Asia Institute. pp.3-11.

News periodical

Surname, Initial. (date) 'Article Title', News periodical, Place, month and day.

Carothers, T. (2011) 'Egypt and Indonesia.' *The New Republic*, Washington D.C., February 2.
