Minor chemical exposure	Eye Injury – no visual loss	Open Fractures Fractures with Internal Fixation
Skin Irritation	Near Drowning	Amputation of Limb
Sun Burns	Injuries arising from motor vehicle accidents	Injury resulting in Permanent Loss of Bodily Function
