The Ministry of Justice, Communication and Foreign Affairs of the Government of Tuvalu presents its compliments to All Diplomatic Missions, Regional and International Organizations accredited to the Government of Tuvalu and with reference to the Former's note TUV:3/20/All, has the honour to inform that in response to the global coronavirus epidemic, the Government of Tuvalu has made changes to the duration to which travelers must remain in isolation when travelling through high-risk countries.

In this regard, the Ministry wishes to advise that all travelers visiting a high-risk country must obtain a medical clearance 3 days prior entering Tuvalu and must remain in a country other than those listed as high-risk for at least 14 days before entering Tuvalu.

The Ministry of Justice, Communication and Foreign Affairs of the Government of Tuvalu avails itself of the opportunity to renew to All Diplomatic Missions, Regional and International Organizations accredited to the Government of Tuvalu the assurances of its highest consideration.
