Abstract from Thesis

"Employment Relations in Fiji's Hotel Sector: The Impact of the Employment Relations Act 2007 as an Outcome of Labor Market Reform"

Fiji's economic reform plan was introduced in small doses in the 1970s. However, it finally took shape in the 1990s through international trade reform, public sector reform, goods market reform, financial market reform, and labour market reform. The labour market reform resulted in the Employment Relations Act (ERA) 2007. Fiji's reform agendas were confronted by political instability, which impacted the employment relations system in Fiji due to inconsistencies and controversies. The research sought to determine if the ERA 2007 has had some impacts on employment relation actors, practices, processes, and outcomes in Fiji's hotel sector. No study was done in the past, but this research has provided a platform for the future. Both qualitative and quantitative research methods were used. Funding limitations dictated the research to focus only on Fiji's two main islands. However, the research data analysis was majorly qualitative but thematic in nature. The research discovered the Landowners Committee (LOC), a new actor of employment relations in Fiji's hotel sector. This finding supported the pluralist theory's argument on the multiple interest groups that created the dual source of authority. The LOC brings forth the third source of authority, establishing the 'Tri-source of loyalty' model. This makes the employment relations in the Fiji hotel sector unique. This discovery contributes to the existing literature on employment relations. The wage-setting models used are the basis of wage disparities in Fiji's hotel sector. However, the wage-setting model is shifting to a productivity-based one. This shift is influenced by globalization, which brings a very competitive global market environment to Fiji's hotel sector. The mandatory provisions of the ERA 2007 impact the nature of employment relations in Fiji's hotel sector. The ERA 2007 formalises the informal practices and norms to the advantage of Fiji hotel employees. However, the ERA 2007 has no impact on hotel employee's absenteeism, staff turnover, grievances, satisfaction, motivation, commitment, loyalty, productivity, strike, and lockout in Fiji's hotel sector.

Abstract from Thesis

"There is No Place Like Home: Exploring Locals' Domestic Travel Behaviour"

The study explores the citizens' behaviour towards domestic travel intention and the developments in domestic tourism. The justification for this study lies in the fact that with the closure of borders due to the COVID-19 pandemic, domestic tourism has become more critical than ever for the survival of the tourism industry in Fiji. By integrating the theory of consumer ethnocentrism and the theory of planned behaviour, the study examines tourism ethnocentrism within Fiji's tourism context. Employing an online survey distributed via SurveyMonkey and promoted through sponsored advertisements, the study gathered 532 responses. The hypotheses were tested using covariance-based structural equation modelling (CB-SEM) through SPSS and AMOS software.

Results indicate that attitude, subjective norms, perceived behavioural control, and tourism ethnocentrism were positively associated with the willingness to visit a local destination, which was positively associated with local travel behaviour. This willingness also correlates positively with local travel behaviour and perceived social return. The study further explores the moderating effects of price sensitivity, tourism ethnocentrism, and cultural variables such as espoused uncertainty avoidance and collectivism on these relationships. It was found that price sensitivity strengthens the positive relationship between attitude and willingness to visit local destinations, whereas espoused individualism negatively moderates the relationship between tourism ethnocentrism and resident support for tourism. Additionally, the study introduces tourism xenophilia as a moderating factor, revealing its negative moderation on the relationship between attitude and willingness to visit local destinations.

The study makes several theoretical contributions to the literature on domestic tourism, notably by highlighting the underexplored domain of domestic compared to international tourism, introducing and testing tourism xenophilia as a negative predictor of domestic travel behaviour, applying the social return and tourism xenophilia scales to a developing country context, testing perceived social return as a dependent variable, and providing insights on how domestic travel experiences influences a traveler's social image. These findings underscore the complexity of factors influencing domestic tourism development and the need for nuanced strategies to foster resident support and engagement in domestic travel within Fiji.

Abstract from Thesis

"A Critical Appraisal of Consumer Protection in the Regulation of General Insurance in Fiji"

According to the Reserve Bank of Fiji, the regulator of the insurance industry, only 12% of Fiji's adult population is covered under some form of insurance. The large, and growing uninsured population in Fiji, particularly for general insurance, constitutes a pressing problem of social security and economic sustainability for the nation. Thus, the purpose of this research was to investigate the legal reasons for the lack of penetration of insurance.

A hybrid research methodology comprising qualitative and quantitative was adopted. Data were collected through a questionnaire, which was further analysed using a simple distributive analysis. A comparative and critical analysis of the consumer protection provisions in Fiji, the United Kingdom, and Australia were examined, which allowed the researcher to determine the shortfalls in the Fijian legislation. The reasons for choosing the United Kingdom and Australian legislation are (a) the United Kingdom has been a world-leading expert in the field of insurance; (b) until 1970, Fiji was a colony of the United Kingdom that shaped the modern legislation for Fiji; and (c) the Australian experience provided invaluable guidance for Fiji as Fiji's experience by far remained modest in comparison with Australia.

The thesis consists of six chapters. Chapter 1 provides a brief overview of the problem of the lack of penetration of general insurance in Fiji. The objective of this chapter is to draw the reader's attention to this problem faced by the insurance industry and the reasons behind it. Chapter 2 begins with a brief legislative history of insurance law in Fiji. The chapter further explores the post-independence era of insurance law in Fiji and reflects two main objectives – prudential regulation and consumer protection. Chapter 3 provides an understanding of how the insurance sector works concerning consumer protection and further explores the insurance rules from the point of view of the consumer and the insurer to evaluate what is going on in the insurance industry in Fiji. Chapter 4 is dedicated to the empirical study to find out the first-hand reasons for the lack of insurance penetration in Fiji. Chapter 5 is a comparative and critical discussion of consumer protection provisions in the regulatory framework in Fiji, the United Kingdom, and Australia. The chapter further explores numerous decisions of the courts in the United Kingdom and Australia on the interpretation and application of consumer protection provisions. Although case laws of the UK, and Australia are not binding on the courts in Fiji, they are highly persuasive. Chapter 6 concludes by considering the reform of consumer protection law to address the concerns of Fijians.

The study showed that the major contributing factors to less penetration of the general insurance sector in Fiji are: (a) the failure of the regulatory framework to sufficiently protect the interests of consumers and potential consumers of insurance services, (b) the lack of consumer protection enforcement mechanisms, and (c) the lack of consumer awareness on insurance. The research concluded that the Insurance Act 1998 (Fiji) is obsolete, outdated, and obscure to the extent that it needs overwhelming reform to promote socio-economic development, and maintain stability in the industry and financial system, at large. Further research will be required to explore the possibility of insurance as a public financial institution in Fiji.

Abstract from Thesis

"The Politics of Resource Distributions: The Case of Rural Constituency Development Fund (RCDF) in Solomon Islands"

As a relatively new initiative, Constituency Development Funds (CDFs) are aimed at addressing issues of poverty, public service delivery and underdevelopment in often remote or rural areas in developing countries. Their rising popularity and adoption are in large part due to significant failures by centralized governments to deliver basic services to their more peripheral populations. In conjunction with wider decentralization agendas, CDFs are intended to devolve certain fiscal responsibilities and decision-making to lower subsidiary levels of authority that are supposedly better placed to make expenditure and project decisions based on a greater awareness of community interests and needs. Although the rationale behind the establishment of such funds is laudable and they have considerable normative appeal, in practice, their implementation and function has been far from straightforward with some decidedly ambiguous and uneven outcomes in developing countries. In the case of Solomon Islands, a form of discretionary fiscal disbursement responsibility is passed to Members of Parliament by way of what is known as the Rural Constituency Development Fund (RCDF). This thesis places under qualitative scrutiny the paradigmatic features and claims of CDFs against the practice and politics of RCDF resource distribution in Solomon Islands. It investigates the ways in which the

RCDF's implementation, disbursement and use has shaped public service delivery and development across a set of in-country case study locations. The thesis triangulates a range of qualitative respondent interview data with survey data and official electoral and acquittal records to gauge the gap between general assumptions on CDFs and an on the ground reality. In the studied cases, RCDF is increasingly politicized to ensure incumbents' hold on political power. Moreover, the thesis underscores that kin-based dynamics continue to underpin multiple facets of local politics, from voting behaviour to resource distribution in constituencies in Solomon Islands. The findings convincingly indicate that despite laudable intentions, RCDF's translation into practice has met with limited success in Solomon Islands.

Abstract from Thesis

"Exploring the diet-related drivers of obesity, overweight and non-communicable diseases: Perceptions of food gatekeepers from an urban indigenous community in Fiji"

Obesity in Pacific Island Countries (PICs) like Fiji is hitting crisis levels and it is estimated that eight out of ten Fijians are at risk of being obese (World Obesity, 2023). Fiji, also has one of the highest rates of deaths caused by non-communicable diseases (NCDs) in the world: In Fiji, 84% of all deaths are caused by NCDs and nearly a third of Fijian adults are at risk of dying prematurely due to NCDs (WHO, 2018). Literature from PICs suggest that nutrition transitions is one of the main causes of the obesity and NCD epidemic in PICs. This dissertation explored the diet-related drivers of obesity, overweight and NCD's in an urban indigenous (iTaukei) community in Fiji. Specifically, it recorded how individual and environmental influences shape the value attached to different types of food and norms around food choices and eating practices which impact healthy and unhealthy eating, over-eating and influence nutrition transitions within this urban iTaukei community. The findings of the four studies that comprise this dissertation indicate that interventions within this community are specifically needed to address (1) cultural beliefs and practices that emphasize abundance of food and over-eating, plate-clearing and attitudes such as kana meda bula which normalize and reinforce overeating and unhealthy eating, (2) cultural myths and beliefs around energy needs of men, pregnant and breastfeeding mothers and around equating larger body sizes as signs of health and happiness, (3) the misplaced value on meat, fast foods, junk foods and energy dense foods, (4) misconceptions around ultra-processed foods, and 'healthy' meal patterns and (5) food choice motives that lead to over-eating and unhealthy eating in this community including satiety concerns, convenience, price and sensory appeal (especially taste. These findings reinforce the need for a multi-level intervention and can inform policy, nutrition education and diet-related interventions within this population.

Abstract from Thesis

"Ethno-Meteorological Knowledge: Local Indicators and Perceptions of Weather and Seasons from Choiseul, Solomon Islands"

Ethno-meteorological knowledge (EMK), the indigenous and local knowledge (ILK) about weather and seasons, has never been written in Choiseul, northwest Solomon Islands, and is in danger of becoming diluted with time and vanished from indigenous communities. Lack of interest among youths, the passing away of elderly custodians, and modernisation contribute to the problem. A mixed method approach was used to document and examine EMK to understand the level of knowledge retained and practiced by Choiseulese, and recommend measures for future implications on policies and sustainability. A better knowledge of the EMK should play an important role in determining suitable mitigation and adaptation strategies toward climate variability and extreme events.

Eighty-seven indigenous weather indicators (IWis) were used by Choiseulese to indicate ten different weather conditions. The IWis were categorized into atmospheric, biological, cosmological, geological, hydrological, and marine-based indicators. Seventy two percent of the IWis were used to predict rain, storm, and fine weather, the most popular climatic conditions monitored by Choiseulese. Thirty five percent of the IWis are multi-weather indicators, used to indicate more than one weather condition. The Choiseul Seasonal Calendar describes the flow of life and weather throughout the seasons. Climatic, biological, and cultural events, and lunar periodicity indicate seasonal activities, including fishing, planting, harvesting, and hunting, of certain fish, crops, and animals. Mythology is found to be an integral part of the EMK in Choiseul. Myths, chants, and songs related to the Choiseulese EMK provided cues essential for living and surviving in the local environment.

Continued community use of EMK provides sustainability of this knowledge. This study presents a systematic way of appraising the perceptions of Choiseulese concerning the ILK/EMK based upon the socio-demographic variables of the respondents corresponding to their perceptions on who should be teaching ILK, who is evaluating the weather daily, and the usefulness of the SIBC weather forecasts. The study underscores the urgent need to document EMK before the original knowledge is completely diluted or dies away. Two local narratives in Choiseul were compared with climate data. The study found coherently consistent patterns between the climate data and narrated patterns disclosed by indigenous observations and experiences, supporting the proposition that indigenous weather knowledge can complement weather and seasonal predictions for specific local contexts.

Abstract from Thesis

"Climate Change Implications for Secondary School Agricultural Science Curriculum in Fiji"

An intertwined relationship exists between agriculture and climate change as agriculture contributes towards and is also affected by CC. Investigation of how well climate change phenomena is integrated in the Agricultural Science curriculum as such become imperative. Systemic studies on Agricultural Science Curriculum in Fiji are limited. A qualitative study was conducted in Labasa, Fiji Islands to ascertain the coverage of climate change in Fiji's secondary school Agricultural Science Curriculum. Research tools of questionnaires, semi-structured interviews, *Talanoa*, and document analysis were used to gather the study data. The participants for the study constituted of Year 13 Agricultural Science students, Agricultural Science teachers, Senior Education Officers, and Senior Agriculture Officers. Interpretive analysis, thematic and descriptive analysis were employed for data analysis. The study findings suggested the need for a greater emphasis of climate change phenomena in the curriculum. Agricultural causes of climate change, the impact of climate change on agriculture along with the various agricultural mitigation and adaptation strategies are to be more rigorously included in the curriculum. A lack of rich climate change conceptualization was found amongst Agricultural Science students and teachers. Mass media was identified as an important source of climate change information for the students.

The first three panels represent, in order from top, **FIJI ISLANDS**, **TONGA**, and **SAMOA**. In each case the central motif was adopted from a traditional tapa of each country. While the motifs appear to be stylised flower or star patterns, the symbolic significance of these ancient designs has long since been lost. This is also true of the more geometric elements of the border patterns. Other inspirations are more obvious: the Fijian comb pattern features at the top and the bottom of the entire tapa; frigate birds are between the panels for Fiji and Tonga; and cannibal forks feature between the Tonga and Samoa panels.

The fourth panel represents **SOLOMON ISLANDS** and has as its main motif a lengga nut design from a kap-kap shell ornament, which is traditionally worn around the neck. The striated triangles at the edges were taken from a carved war club.

The central motif for the fifth panel, representing **KIRIBATI**, is taken from a fine woven mat. This is bordered on each side by a stylised shark's tooth spear and is separated from the panel above by a design taken from the finely woven sinnet cord featured on the haft of the spear.

Between the fifth panel and the sixth panels representing **TUVALU**, is a turtle border design taken from a Fijian tapa. The Tuvalu star pattern is also taken from a mat design and the border represents the ancient bamboo flute which is still sometimes played in Tonga.

The seventh panel represents **COOK ISLANDS**. In the centre is a motif from a carved ritual adze from Mangaia while the bottom border is taken from a wooden food bowl.

The **VANUATU** panel beneath features a design from a rare ritual head-dress of the Banks Islands and is bordered by a pattern which is said to represent the marks made by crabs walking across wet sand.

The ninth panel is for **NIUE**. Its central motif, the bent cross pattern on the sides, and the flying birds which separate this panel from the one above are all taken from a very old tapa returned to Niue from New Zealand. The centre design is common throughout the entire Oceania/Indonesia region.

The panel for **TOKELAU** is taken from a woven mat, and is separated from that for Niue by a stylised crab design.

The eleventh panel represents **NAURU** and shows string figures, which are a traditional art form. The central figure tells a legend of twin babies fighting for milk at their mother's breast, while the side figures depict flying fish.

The final panel is for **MARSHALL ISLANDS**. The top and side borders come from a traditional Marshall Islands mat weave, referring to lineage and land inheritance. The side borders are joor, meaning pillar, and refer to the important positions of chiefs and lineage heads. The central motif is a navigation stick chart, rebbelib or meddo, used by the ancient sailing masters to chart currents and islands.

Ceremonial Dress

The ceremonial dress of the University of the South Pacific was designed in light weight materials to be appropriate for tropical conditions. The principal colours reflect the brown of tapa or masi found throughout the Pacific, while the blue derives from the colour of the sea and the sky.

Officer's Robe

Chancellor: The gown is made from brown Indian silk with long sleeves lined with cream silk. The facings are six-inch (fifteen-centimetre) wide strips of specially designed tapa motifs representative of all the member countries of the University Region. The material is gathered at the yoke. The headgear is a trencher covered with brown Indian silk, with matching braid round the lower edge, and a brown tassel.

Pro-Chancellor: The gown is as for the Chancellor, but with the unlined sleeves. The headgear is as for the Chancellor without the braid.

Vice-Chancellor: The gown is as for the Pro-Chancellor, but the facings are four-inch (ten centimetres) wide strips of tapa. The headgear is as for the Pro-Chancellor.

Academic Dress

Doctor of the University: The gown is in dark blue Indian silk with pleats on each side at the back. The sleeves have a horizontal lower edge and a slit in the front. Facings down the front of the gown are in light blue Indian silk, as are the linings of the sleeves. The hood is a simple cowl twice the size of the bachelor's hood with a lining in light blue. The headgear is a trencher in dark blue Indian silk with a light blue tassel.

Master of the University: A dark brown master's gown, with a light blue lining for the hood and front V attaching it. The headgear is a dark brown trencher.

Doctor of Philosophy: The gown is as for the Doctor of the University but the sleeves are unlined and the facings are in red. The hood is as for the Doctor of the University hood but the lining is red. The headgear is a trencher in dark blue Indian silk with a red tassel.

Master's Degree: Gowns should be of cotton in the dark brown colour of the usual deep shade of tapa cloth patterns, in a simple design with three pleats on each side at the back. The sleeves come down to knee level. The hood is a simple cowl lined with the following degree colours: forest green for Agriculture, gold for Arts, purple for Business Administration, teal for Commerce, cream for Education, aqua blue for Engineering, silver grey for Law, brick red for Medicine, palm green for Science; and pale pink for Master in Computing and Information Systems (MCIS) and Master of Information Systems (MIS). The front finished in a two-inch (five-centimetre) wide V which is in the degree colour. The headgear, which is optional, is a trencher in a light-weight matching brown fabric.

Master of Philosophy: A dark brown gown and plain dark brown hood.

Postgraduate Diplomas and Certificates: A dark brown gown only, the same colour and design as the master's degree.

Professional Diplomas and Certificates: A dark brown gown only, the same colour and design as the master's degree.


Bachelor's Degree: Gowns are of the same design as for the master's degree, but in a lighter shade of tapa brown. The hood is lined in the discipline colours as defined by the master's dress. In addition, orange is assigned for the Bachelor of Software Engineering (BSE) & Bachelor of Network and Security, and magenta for the Bachelor of Geospatial Science. The front V attaching the hood is in plain brown. The headgear, a trencher, is in the same light tapa brown of the gown. **Combined programmes:** Where two programmes are completed simultaneously resulting in the award of 2 certificates, the recipient shall wear two hoods (each depicting the colour of the two qualifications) as part of their academic dress.

Diplomas and Certificates: A light tapa brown gown only, the same colour and design as the bachelor's degree.
